What is PACE?



You have a voice! With PACE, a team of health care professionals works with you to make decisions about your care.

The PACE program helps adults with long-term care needs to be served in the community whenever possible.

These professionals take time to get to know you, your living situation and your specific needs.

You, along with your family or representative, work with your PACE center team to create a personalized care plan for your goals.

Who qualifies?



To qualify for PACE, an individual must meet the following conditions:

- Be 55 or older.
- Live in a PACE service area.
- Need nursing-home level of care (as certified by the state).
- Be able to live safely in the community with help from PACE services.

PACE accepts:

- SoonerCare (Oklahoma Medicaid)
- Medicare
- Private pay

What is covered?



PACE benefits and services include but are not limited to:

- Primary care
- Adult day care
- Prescription drugs
- Physical therapy
- Occupational therapy
- Recreational services
- Nutritional counseling
- Social services
- Transportation
- Laboratory/X-ray services
- Hospital care
- Medical specialty services
- Nursing home care, if needed
